### Facility Brings New Generation of Residential Aged Care and Jobs to Toowoomba

Construction is well underway of Infinite Care's new residential aged care facility in Stuart Street, Mt Lofty. This new home will bring a never before seen level of premium aged care choice to the residents of Toowoomba and will create over 200 jobs for the region. The home will help address a shortfall in first class aged care service provision for the region.

Infinite Care has a strong pedigree in residential aged care and the Toowoomba facility will be its first foray into the Queensland market. The Group's head office is located on the Gold Coast and it currently operates a number of facilities in the South Australian market. The group has a pipeline of new aged care facilities planned to open across Australia over the coming years. Perched high on Stuart Street, Mt Lofty, residents will be afforded sweeping views of the city. Infinite Care Toowoomba adjoins Heritage Oval/Southern Cross Reserve and Horn Park. Residents will be able to enjoy views from many areas in the facility of all the activities of all sporting clubs and associations using these facilities and further engender the community connection for all residents. Infinite Care Toowoomba will be unlike any aged care facility the city has seen before and will set a new benchmark for resident care, lifestyle and community centred involvement.

The facility is conveniently located close to the Northpoint Shopping precinct, local bowls club, medical practices and public transport. There is a wide range of room choice available, with varying inclusions, outlooks and price points to suit a wide range of residents. The facility will also include a specialised 32 bed Memory Support Unit, up to 20 separate dining and lounge areas, regeneration zones, wellness centre, hair dresser and beauty salon, gym, theatre room, café, children's playground, and function rooms.

Infinite will deploy a new generation of care model which will mean some new and exciting employment offerings for a large number of local Toowoomba residents that may want to join the Infinite team.

Infinite's Joint Managing Director, Chris Stride said that 'The project is a significant milestone for the Infinite group as Toowoomba will be the first of its new generation facilities being developed across Australia. We're excited that our flagship home will be part of the Toowoomba community from late 2018.'
